Month I and Month 2

These months focus on: Personal development and the role including the duties and responsibilities of your own role, standards, regulatory requirements and agreed ways of working and reflecting on work activities.

Month 4

This month focuses on: Health and safety in the workplace and risk assessments. Responding to accidents and sudden illness and reducing the spread of infection. Handling equipment and hazardous materials and managing own stress.

Month 6

This month focuses on: Communication and handling information including confidentiality in a health and social care setting.

Months II, I2 and I3

These months focuses on: Preparation for Gateway and End Point Assessment including reviewing the portfolio of evidence.

Month 3

This month focuses on: Duty of care and safeguarding including relevant legislation and policies, the signs and / or symptoms associated with abuse and the role of different agencies in safeguarding and protection.

Month 5

This month focuses on: Equality, Diversity and personcentred approaches.
